1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device by your browser. They are widely used to make websites work, remember preferences, and provide usage analytics. We also use related technologies such as **localStorage**, **sessionStorage**, **pixels**, and **server-side first-party identifiers**, which we refer to collectively as "cookies" in this notice.

2. Categories of cookies we use

Category	Required?	Purpose	Examples
Strictly necessary	Yes — cannot be disabled	Authentication, session integrity, security (CSRF), load balancing	sb-* (Supabase Auth), __Host-* session cookies
Functional	Optional	Remember your preferences (e.g., theme, sidebar state) and your firm settings	ic-theme , ic-sidebar
Analytics	Optional, consent-based where required by law	Aggregated, privacy-preserving usage analytics so we can prioritize improvements	[ANALYTICS PROVIDER if any] (none enabled by default)
Marketing	Optional, consent-based	Measure marketing-page conversions; we do not run cross-context behavioral advertising	[MARKETING PROVIDER if any] (none enabled by default)

If you have not configured Analytics or Marketing providers, remove or update those rows accordingly. Not running them is also a perfectly defensible posture.

3. Third-party cookies

Some cookies are set by third parties we use to provide the Service (e.g., the payment processor's hosted checkout page may set its own cookies during a checkout session). Those third parties' privacy and cookie practices are governed by their own policies; we link to them in `07-subprocessor-list.md`.

4. Your choices

- **Browser controls.** Most browsers let you block or delete cookies. Disabling strictly necessary cookies will break sign-in and other core features.
- **Consent banner.** Where required by law (e.g., EEA, UK, California), we display a consent banner the first time you visit the marketing pages. You can change your selections at any time via the "Cookie preferences" link in the footer.
- **Do Not Track.** Web browsers may send a "Do Not Track" signal. There is no industry consensus on how to interpret it; the Service does not currently respond to DNT.
- **Global Privacy Control.** We honor the Global Privacy Control (GPC) signal as a request to opt out of the "sale" or "sharing" of personal information for cross-context behavioral advertising. We do not engage in such sale or sharing today.
